As per report received from SEOCs, the following persons have been died/injured due to lightning/thunder storm during intervening night 16-17th April'2019 in the following states.

This Ministry is regularly sharing the weather update received from IMD to SEOCs of all concerned states/UTs.

Weather Warning during next 5 days

17 April (Day 1): ♦ Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph) accompanied with hail and lightning at isolated places very likely over East Madhya Pradesh and Chhattisgarh.

♦ Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph) accompanied and lightning at isolated places very likely over Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places very likely over Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, East Rajasthan, West Madhya Pradesh, Vidarbha, Odisha, Arunachal Pradesh, Marathwada, Telangana, Rayalaseema, South Interior Karnataka, Tamilnadu and Kerala.

♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over interior Tamilnadu.

18 April (Day 2): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with squall (wind speed reaching 50-60 kmph) and lightning at isolated places very likely over Odisha and Kerala.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places very likely over Uttarakhand, Chhattisgarh, Bihar, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura, Telangana, Rayalaseema, South Interior Karnataka and Tamilnadu.

♦ Heavy rainfall at isolated places very likely over Arunachal Pradesh and Kerala.

19 April (Day 3): ♦ Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph) accompanied with hail and lightning at isolated places likely over Odisha.

♦ Thundersquall (wind speed reaching 60-70 kmph) accompanied and lightning at isolated places very likely over Gangetic West Bengal and Kerala.

♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places likely over Tamilnadu, South Interior Karnataka, Telangana, north Coastal Andhra Pradesh, Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh and Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram & Tripura.

20 April (Day 4): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places likely over Gangetic West Bengal, Odisha, Tamilnadu, Telangana and Coastal Andhra Pradesh.

♦ Heat Wave conditions at isolated pockets likely over Rajasthan.

21 April (Day 5): ♦ Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty winds (wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph) and lightning at isolated places likely over Uttarakhand, Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Telangana.

♦ Heat Wave conditions at some parts likely over Rajasthan
