

Name of Scheme : **Delhi Police Building Programme**

Implementing office: **Delhi Police**

The scheme of Delhi Police Building Programme is primarily meant for providing Residential/Office Buildings for use of maximum number of Delhi Police personnel and to own regular buildings for all Police Stations/police posts/Offices of Delhi Police. This scheme consists of two sub schemes i.e. (a)Office Building &(b) Residential Building.

The scheme for the 12th Plan period (2012-2017) was allocated an outlay of Rs.1117.25 crore. In the 12th Plan period 66 projects were taken up which inter-alia include 2750 Qtrs., 33 Police Stations, 16 Police Posts and 02 District Lines. Out of these 66 projects, 44 projects have been completed (846 Qtrs., 24 Police Stations, 15 Police Posts); 14 projects are under construction (1717 Qtrs., 7 Police Stations, 02 District Lines); 07 projects are at planning stage; One projects is for Extra Ordinary Repair of Office and Residential Buildings. Land procurement is made as pre-investment activity.

Presently 194 Police stations are functioning in Delhi. Out of 194, 133 police stations are running in regular building and 7 PS building are under construction. 16 Police stations are running in PP Building and 21 Police Stations are functioning in temporary structure/semi permanent/porta cabin. 13 Police stations are functioning in rented accommodation. 04 Police stations are functioning in the building of other police stations. Presently, the housing satisfaction level of Delhi Police personnel is only 19.87%. There is shortage of land in Delhi and availability of lands will become nominal in the coming years. Hence, suitable lands have been identified in all cases on the basis of availability of suitable land and requirement of buildings for police stations/police posts/lines and residential quarters.

Constructing new PS buildings, PP buildings, Office buildings, District Lines and Housing complexes will provide a healthy atmosphere/environment to the police personnel as well as to increase the housing satisfaction level of Delhi Police personnel.

An amount of Rs.249.51 crore has been utilized during 2017-18 under the Delhi Police Building Programme. An amount of Rs.372.75 crore has been allocated under BE 2018-19. Construction of ongoing projects and projects at Planning stage taken up during 12th Plan will be expedited and completed. Apart from above, 32 new projects (30 Office Buildings + 2 Residential Buildings) along with procurement of land for 42 projects are to be taken up in 2018-19 and 2019-20. 'Extra Ordinary Repair' of Office and Residential Buildings under Delhi Police Building Programme at a cost of Rs.134.48 crore including Rs.103.38 crore for Residential Buildings and Rs.31.10 crore for Office Buildings is also being undertaken for implementation during the years 2017-18 & 2018-19 as per the availability of budget.
