

Introduction to IS-II Division
Role and function

1. Legal Section:

Mutual Legal Assistance in criminal matters & Extradition matters:

- (i) Letters of request received from and going to MLAT and non MLAT countries
- (ii) Service of Judicial processes in bailable criminal matters outside India
- (iii) TADA cases - monitoring
- (iv) Extradition requests to foreign countries

2. NSA Section:

NSA, 1980 and representations there under including court cases on the subject:

- (i) Administration of the National Security Act, 1980 and related policy matters on preventive detention.
- (ii) Individual detentions/releases made by the States, Union Territories and the Central Government under this Act.
- (iii) Examination of reports received from State Governments and Union Territories under Section 3(5) of the National Security Act.
- (iv) Statutory representations addressed to the Central Government in regard to the detentions made under the National Security Act, 1980 made by the detainees and his/her family members or by others on his/her behalf and also examining the comments of the State Government on such representations.
- (v) Writ Petitions arising out of detentions made under the National Security Act, 1980.
- (vi) Filing of Special Leave Petition in the Supreme Court of India challenging the orders of High Courts.

3. NCB I & II Section:

All administrative, establishment and financial matters including budget of Narcotics Control Bureau and

- (i) Strengthening of NCB in terms of manpower, buildings, equipment, etc.
- (ii) All matters relating to release of Central Assistance to States for enforcement of their capabilities to combat illicit trafficking in narcotics drugs and psychotropic substances.

4. Coordination Section:

Privileges of MPs outside Parliament

- (i) Notices from MPs regarding breach of their privileges outside Parliament received through Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha Secretariat.
- (ii) Taking up the same with the concerned State Governments and UTs.
- (iii) Examination of replies received from State Governments and UTs and apprising the Lok Sabha Secretariat / Rajya Sabha Secretariat as the case may be.

5. VTV Section:

Scheme of Central Assistance to the beneficiaries of civilian/victims of terrorist/ communal/ LWE violence, cross border firing, mines/IED blasts on Indian Territory for the sustenance and maintenance of their families (VTV).

- (i) Receipts of proposals from the concerned District Magistrate/ Commissioners from State Government/ UTs
- (ii) Examination of the proposals received from the DM/State Governments in accordance with Scheme.
- (iii) Release of Central Assistance in eligible cases.
