**Union Home Minister reviews security scenario in J&K at a high-level meeting in  
Srinagar**

The Union Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh reviewed the security scenario in Jammu and Kashmir at a high-level meeting in Srinagar today in the aftermath of the Pulwama attack on a CRPF convoy. J&K Governor Shri Satya Pal Malik, Advisors to the Governor, Union Home Secretary Shri Rajiv Gauba, Director General, CRPF Shri Rajeev Rai Bhatnagar, GoC-in-C, Army's Northern Command Lt. General Ranbir Singh, and senior security officers from the CAPFs and central agencies, State Police and MHA took part in the deliberations.

Earlier on his arrival in Srinagar, the Union Home Minister paid homage to the CRPF martyrs. Shri Rajnath Singh laid wreath and observed two minutes silence in memory of their supreme sacrifice. In a rare show of solidarity, the Union Home Minister turned pall-bearer, lending shoulder to the coffin of a martyr.
