

Schemes of Delhi Police	
	<p>i) <u>Modernization of Traffic and Communication network of Delhi Police:</u> This scheme consists of the following three sub schemes :-</p> <p>(a) <u>Road Safety Cell</u> :- Delhi Traffic Police is striving to inculcate road safety culture by improving the road user behavior, so that road user can make an optimum use of the roads in a disciplined and orderly manner. Road Safety publicity is being carried out through mass media of AIR/FM/TV and newspaper etc. as per DAVP approved rates. Traffic Training is also imparted through regular exhibitions to spread awareness about observance of norms of road safety. Road safety literature is printed and distributed in schools, traffic training parks, major intersections of Delhi/New Delhi. In addition, road safety functions/ seminars/ marches are also held frequently for generating road safety awareness amongst the public motorists/ school children. The budget is being utilized for purchase of various traffic equipments/accessories, on advertisements & publicity and for maintenance of the existing signals/blinkers etc. An amount of Rs.44.10 Cr. has been allocated under this sub-head in BE 2017-18.</p> <p>(b) <u>Developing Traffic and Communication Network in NCR/Megacities and Model Traffic System:-</u> The Integrated Data Communication Network (Cyber Highway) was established through MTNL on MPLS-VPN network for convergent services in Delhi Police at 243 locations (Police Stations/Offices) in the 11th Plan. The Cyber Highway is continued through the 12th Five Year Plan, because of necessary up-gradation & expansion as required to meet the inclusive connectivity requirement of CCTNS project in Delhi and other requirements of Delhi Police. Under this scheme payment towards recurring components such as bandwidth charges and man power charges are made to MTNL. Funds of Rs.4.40 Cr. has been allocated under this sub-head in BE 2017-18.</p> <p>(c) <u>Traffic Signals/Blinkers:-</u> Under this, new traffic signals/ blinkers are installed and existing signals/blinkers are upgraded for better traffic management. Funds to the tune of Rs.5.50 Cr. has been allocated under this sub-head in BE 2017-18.</p> <p>ii) <u>Induction of Latest Technology and Capacity Building (Nomenclature of the Scheme proposed to be changed as “Purchase of Traffic Equipment and Capacity Building”):</u> This scheme consists following two sub-schemes :-</p> <p>a) Induction of Latest Technology in Delhi Police (<u>Proposed to be amended as Purchase of Traffic Equipment</u>) :- Induction of</p>

state-of-the art traffic control devises with new technologies is a continuous process as the road junction development policy warrants the gradual and timely up-gradation of traffic control and management system to check and control traffic congestion. Under this scheme expenditure is made for installation of state of art modern equipments for regulating and quality enforcement of traffic rules/law. Funds of Rs.0.50 Crore has been allocated under this sub-head in BE 2017-18.

b) Up-gradation of Training in Delhi Police:- Under this Scheme, funds are utilized for procurement of equipments and for upgrading infrastructure for training of Delhi Police personnel. An amount of of Rs.6.50 Cr. has been allocated under this sub-head in BE 2017-18.

iii) Public Private Partnership Projects of Delhi Police :- Dheerpur Housing Complex and Construction of PHQ at Parliament Street are two PPP projects of Delhi Police. An amount of Rs.84.00 Cr. has been allocated under this head in BE 2017-18.

iv) Delhi Police Building Programme:- The Delhi Police Building Programme with its components, namely land, residential buildings, office buildings and extra-ordinary repair, aims at increasing the housing satisfaction level for Delhi Police personnel as well as for providing a good environment to Police personnel, by constructing new Police Station/Police Post/Office Buildings etc. This scheme consists of following two sub-schemes :-

a) Office Building:- An amount of Rs.290.00 Cr. has been allocated under this sub-head in BE 2017-18.

b) Residential Building :- An amount of Rs.65 crore has been allocated under this sub-head in BE 2017-18

v) Scheme for Safety of Women (Financed from Nirbhaya Fund) :- Under this scheme, funds are allocated for the following projects of Delhi Police:

1. New Building for office of Special Unit for Women and Children (SPUWAC) and Special Unit for North East Region (SPUNER) at Nanakpura, New Delhi.
2. Hiring of professional counselors in Delhi Police

In addition, expenditure is also incurred on various activities involved in self-defence training and other women safety related issues.

An amount of Rs.28.90 Cr. has been allocated under this head in BE 2017-18.
