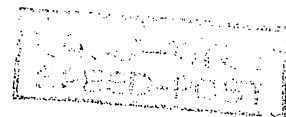

Sub;- Determination of vacancies for appointment by promotion of Gujarat Cadre of Indian Police Service from the Select List of the year- 2018.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Government letter No- IPS/102019/23584/B dated 6th March 2019 on the subject cited and to say that the authorized promotion quota of Gujarat Cadre of IPS as on 01/01/2019 is 63, whereas 51 officers are in position on the due date. Therefore 12 vacancies are available for promotion quota.

2. Out of 12 vacancies, 09 unfilled vacancies has been carry forward from the Select List -2017 and 03 vacancies that is available is due to superannuation of three promote officers, Shri R. V. Jotangia, 31/01/2018, Shri S. G. Bhati 28/02/2018 and Shri S. K. Dave 31/12/2018.

Therefore, in terms of the provisions contained in Rule 4 (2) of the IPS Recruitment Rules, 1954 read with Regulations 5 (1) of the IPS ((Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955, 12 vacancies are determined for the Select list of the year 2018 for appointment by promotion of Gujarat Cadre of Indian Police Service.

4. The State Government and the Commission are requested to take further necessary action as required under the IPS (Appointment by Promotion) Regulations, 1955.
